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Why do Gender Equality Plans matter?

EIGE definition (Horizon Europe)

“A set of commitments and actions that aim to promote gender equality in an organisation through a process of structural change.”

- A GEP is a **roadmap for institutional change**: governance, resources, responsibilities, and monitoring
- It improves **fairness, talent retention, and leadership diversity**
- It strengthens **research and innovation quality** by supporting inclusive practices and, where relevant, integrating the gender dimension

Why institutions still struggle?

- EU recommendations are hard to translate into concrete, prioritised actions adapted to each institution
- Key areas can remain hidden or overlooked, such as governance, data and monitoring, career progression, among others
- Data and responsibilities are often fragmented, with HR, students, research and leadership information spread across different systems and units
- Many institutions face constraints in time and resources, decentralised decision-making, and in Engineering Schools persistent “meritocracy” narratives and “leaky pipeline” challenges
- GEPs can become a list of activities rather than a coherent programme for institutional change

Unite! H2020 Project

Common framework to define effective GEP practice

- Partners reviewed and compared their existing Gender Equality Plans
- A shared framework was developed to organise and compare the different type of actions
- Identification of shared strengths, gaps, and different levels of progress between institutions
- The work highlighted that many plans focus on activities, while fewer include the full cycle of planning, monitoring and improvement

Unite.Widening Project

Challenges

- Many widening Countries institutions have **limited capacity** to design and implement robust GEPs
- There is often a **lack of specialized expertise** and under-resourced equality structures
- **Cultural norms** can hinder more transformative, long-term approaches
- Models imported from non-widening contexts can be **hard to implement**
- **“One approach fits all”** does not work

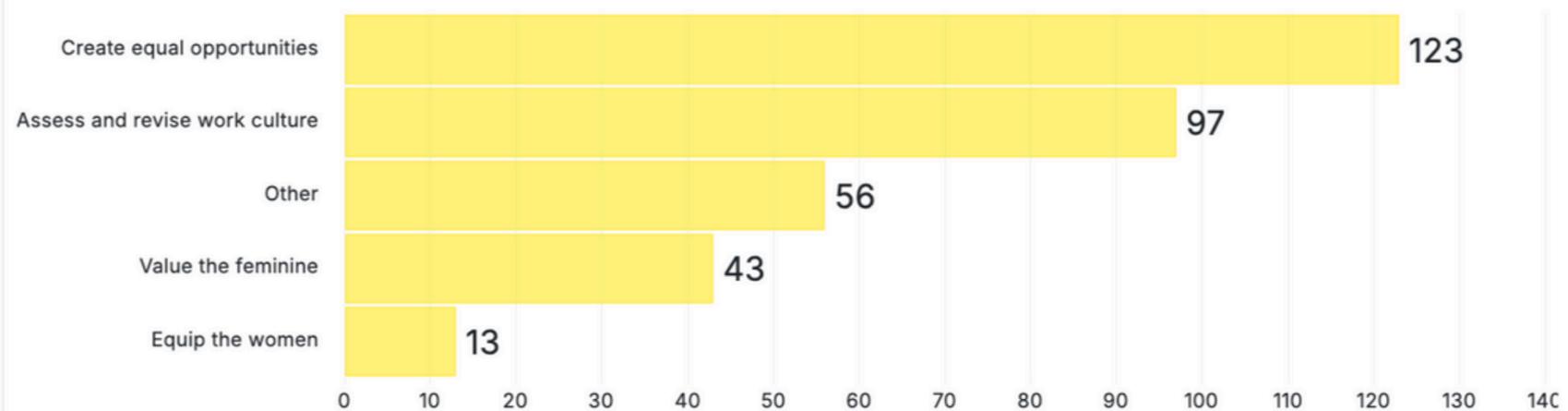

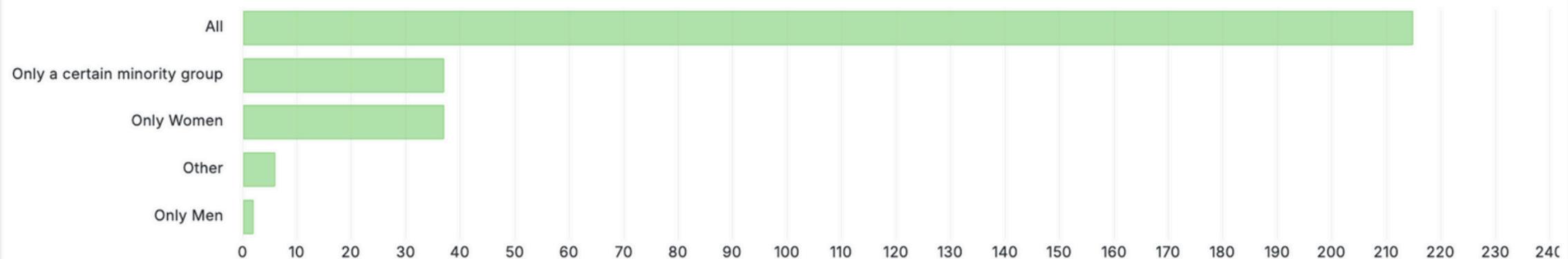
Total Number of Actions



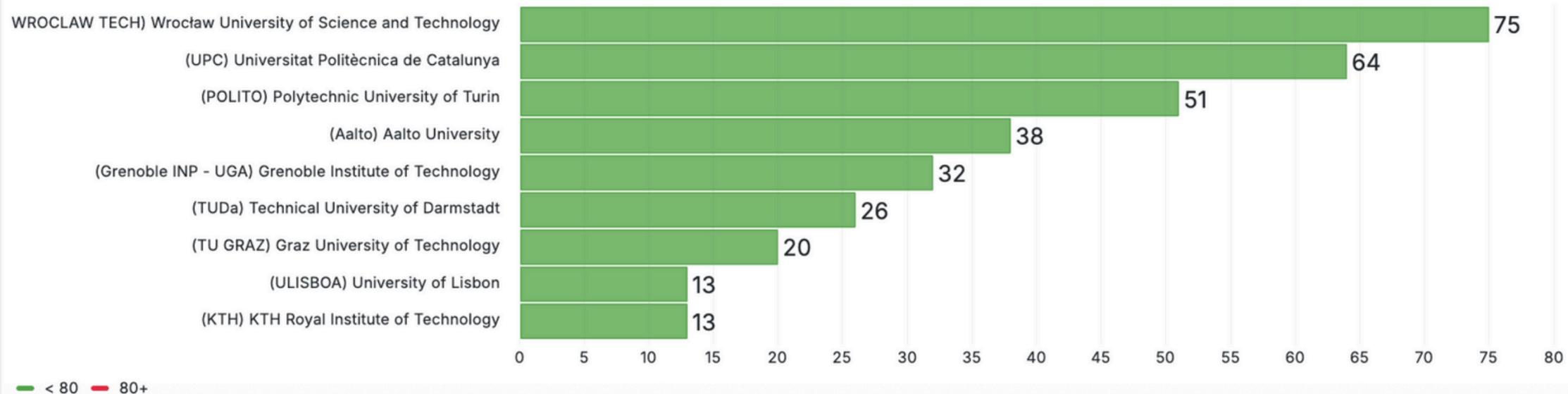
Action Count by Approach
